Why is there BLOOD on the floor !!!



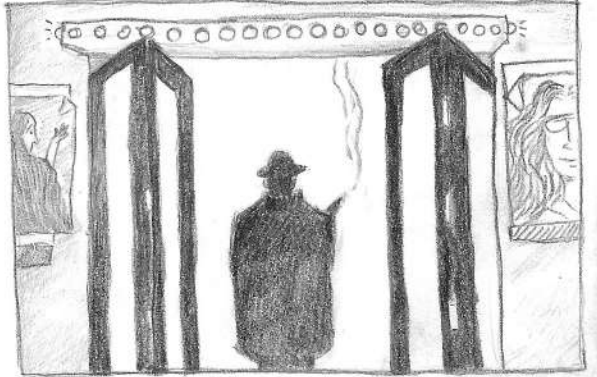

I know it isn't kosher for a Prime Minister global Superpower to take a break from a war. I can tell you, we were just as surprised as you.

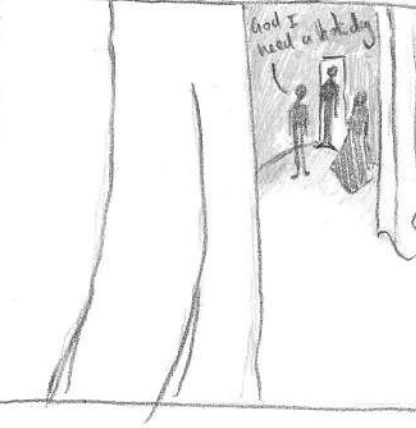
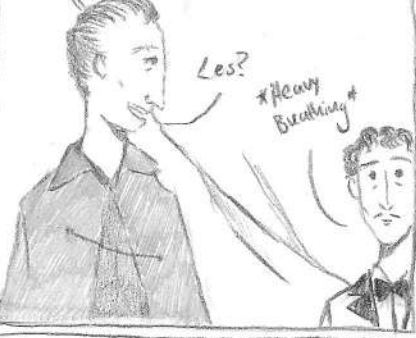
